

## webReader Keyboard Accessibility

More information on access keys can be found in the Help tool, which can be accessed from the webReader toolbar or using Modifier + I. Access keys are activated with modifier keys, which differ depending on the browser and operating system used, see [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Access\\_key](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Access_key). Access keys do not need to be capital letters. Depending on the implementation of webReader, some features might not be activated.

When the user has set focus on the player, **tab/shift+tab** can be used to navigate and the **enter key** to activate a certain button or option.

To access a feature, use Modifier + Access Key	Access Key
<b>Listen button:</b> put focus on Listen button	<b>K</b>
<b>Start reading:</b> put focus on player and start the reading	<b>L</b>
<b>Stop button:</b> put focus on the stop button	<b>X</b>
<b>Move Listen button:</b> put focus on the drag handle of the Listen button, player, and toolbar (LMSs only, not all LMSs)	<b>U</b>
<b>Pop-up Control Panel:</b> put focus on the first button on the pop-up control panel (usually the Pause button)	<b>C</b>
<b>Open/close toolbar</b>	<b>1</b>
 <b>Settings</b>	<b>S</b>
 <b>Reading Language</b> (toolbar must be open, to choose a language)	<b>R</b>
 <b>Click and Listen</b>	<b>H</b>
 <b>Enlarge Text</b>	<b>E</b>
 <b>Text Mode</b>	<b>V</b>
 <b>Page Mask</b>	<b>M</b>
 <b>Download mp3</b>	<b>D</b>
 <b>Help</b>	<b>I</b>
